

Fitting guide for Quattro Air NV



- Remove the elbow from the mask by pressing the side buttons and pulling the elbow away. Then unclip the emergency release pinch clip (not using the cord) to release the lower headgear straps.



- With both lower headgear straps released, hold the mask against the face and pull the headgear over the head. Ensure that the label on the back of the headgear faces outwards when the headgear is put on.



- Undo the fastening tabs on the upper headgear straps. Pull the straps evenly until the mask is stable and positioned as shown in the illustrations. Reattach the fastening tabs.



- Bring the lower straps below the ears. Loop the headgear onto the frame and clip the quick-release together.



- Undo the fastening tabs on the lower headgear straps. Pull the straps evenly until the mask sits firmly on the chin and reattach the fastening tabs.



- Start ventilation and then connect the air tubing from the device to the elbow. Attach the elbow to the mask by pressing the side buttons and pushing the elbow into the mask.



- Readjust the forehead straps so that the mask fits comfortably and an optimal seal is achieved. Overtightening may cause leaks.



- The mask and headgear should be positioned as shown.



Removing the mask using the quick-release cord:

- Pull the quick-release cord down. The quick-release clip separates from the mask.
- Pull the mask away from the face and back over the head.

Optimal cushion positioning



- Align the bottom of the cushion with the crease of the chin and the top of the cushion with the corner of the eye.



- Quattro Air NV sits on the nose at, or below, eye level.

Quattro Air NV has been designed to make initiating NIV easy and effective. Its Spring Air™ cushion is designed to provide a secure seal throughout the mask.



With only five parts, the mask can be assembled in minimal time. And thanks to its quick-release clip with cord, it can be removed quickly and easily in an emergency.




